



Acts 2:1-8, 11b

When the time for Pentecost was fulfilled, they were all in one place together. And suddenly there came from the sky a noise like a strong driving wind, and it filled the entire house in which they were. Then there appeared to them tongues as of fire, which parted and came to rest on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim.

Now there were devout Jews from every nation under heaven staying in Jerusalem. At this sound, they gathered in a large crowd, but they were confused because each one heard them speaking in his own language. They were astounded, and in amazement they asked, “Are not all these people who are speaking Galileans? Then how does each of us hear them in his native language? We hear them speaking in our own tongues the mighty acts of God.”

Conversation Starters

1. What has the Lord personally called you to do for him?
2. What is the mission of your ministry, and how does it participate in the Great Commission?
3. The Holy Spirit is the one who inspires, directs, and gives power to all our evangelization efforts. What does it look like for us to really let the Holy Spirit guide our evangelization efforts?
4. How does your team pray for its ministry and seek God's will? What will your team commit to going forward (types of prayer, time spent in prayer, etc.)?
5. Good prayer is always marked by honesty and consistency. Being afraid and overwhelmed sometimes helps with being honest in prayer. Where do you/we feel desperate and in need of God's intervention?
6. Who do you know that models Mary's relationship with the Holy Spirit? How will you let that person mentor you?
