Relationship	Grows in a personal relationship with Jesus	Helps others develop a personal relationship with Jesus
Prayer	Prays every day	Teaches others how to pray
Commitment	Follows Jesus and the teachings of the Church	Guides others in following Jesus and the teachings of the Church
Worship	Worships the Lord in the Mass and receives the sacraments in faith	Invites others to Mass and to a deeper sacramental life
Study	Reads Sacred Scripture and other Christian writings	Introduces others to Sacred Scripture and other Christian writings
Openness	Listens and responds to where the Holy Spirit is calling	Helps others to be open to the Holy Spirit and where they are being called
Participation	Engages in the life of the community	Walks with others intentionally and helps them to discern where the Lord is calling them to participate
Service	Serves sacrificially in imitation of Jesus	Inspires others to serve sacrificially in imitation of Jesus
Stewardship	Gives generously to others	Helps others to become generous stewards of the gifts they have received
Evangelization	Shares the Gospel through word, witness, and works of mercy	Provides support and formation for others in how to share the Good News
